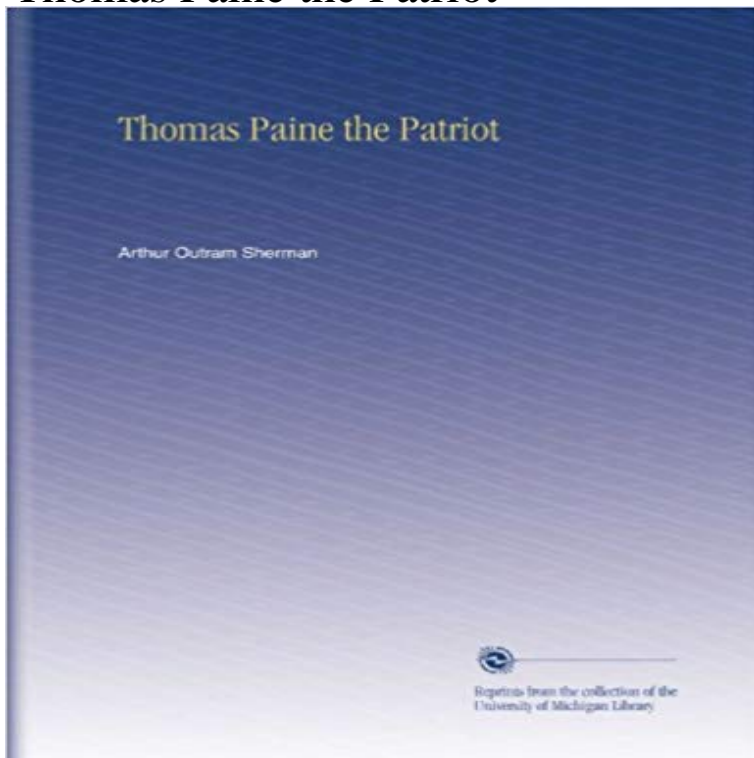


## Thomas Paine the Patriot
