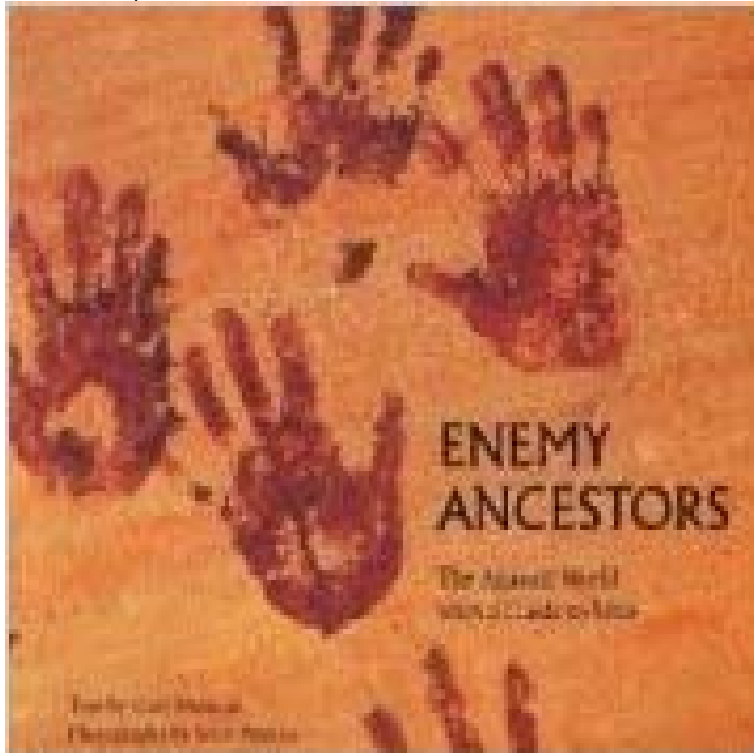


Enemy Ancestors: The Anasazi World, With a Guide to Sites

This book bridges the gap between the many basic books on the Anasazi and the technical publications written by and for archaeologists and anthropologists. It will interest the armchair traveler as well as the person who seeks enlightened participation in the archaeological drama of the Southwest; in addition to covering the geographical, geological, cultural, and domestic contexts of the Anasazi, there is also valuable information on backcountry ethics, field dating methods, and more. Lesser-known extant sites are discussed in general terms, and sources of information for further investigation are also given. The photographer and the author have worked together to produce a lively and lucid examination of an endlessly interesting subject.
