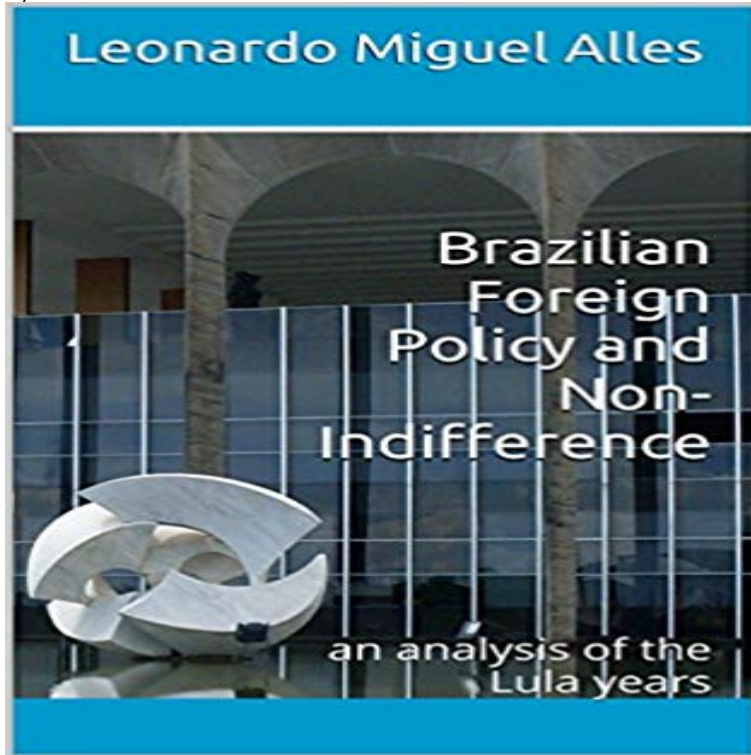


Brazilian Foreign Policy and Non-Indifference: an analysis of the Lula years
