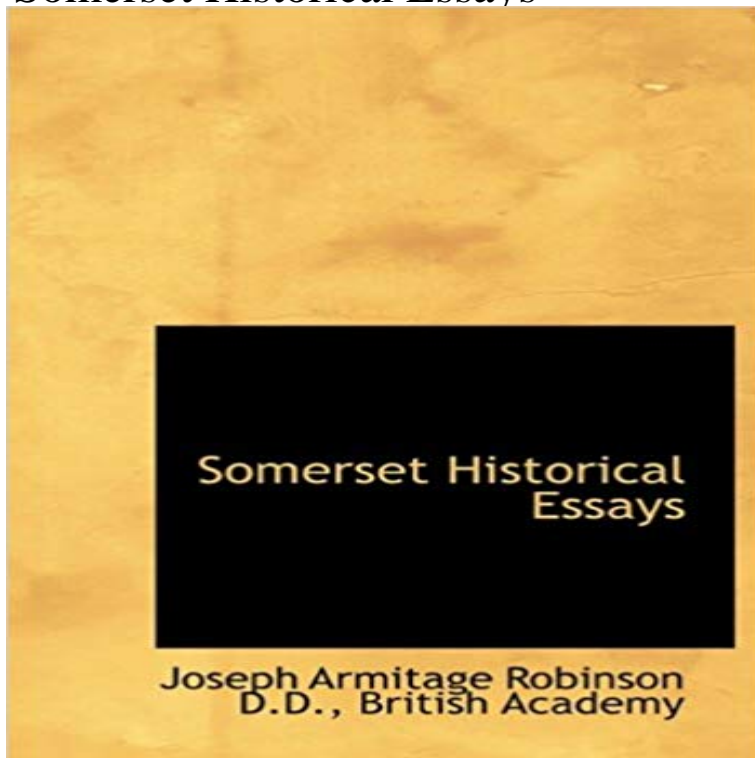


Somerset Historical Essays
